

Flowchart of Progression Regulations for Integrated Master's Degrees to Level 3 and Level 4

Leave the University with award of Integrated Master's Degree

Level 4

Pass 120 credits (which may include up to 20 credits by compensation)

Pass 100 credits or fewer

Leave the University with award of appropriate BA/ BSc Honours degree as exit qualification

Register for and study 120 credits at Level 4 of named programme

Level 3

Progress to Level 4 of Integrated Master's Degree

Pass 120 credits (which may include up to 40 credits by compensation)

Pass 100 credits or fewer

Has the student achieved 300 credits in total including at least 60 credits at Level 3?

Leave the University with award of appropriate BA/ BSc Ordinary degree

Leave the University with award of Diploma of Higher Education (DipHE)

Register for and study 120 credits at Level 3 of named programme

Level 2

Progress to Level 3 of Integrated Master's Degree

Pass 120 credits at Level 2 with at least a 55% average mark

Information on progression at lower levels is contained within the Bachelor's Progression Flowchart. Progression is comparable, except that there are no Ordinary degrees for Integrated Master's programmes, and students who fail modules must therefore withdraw, or transfer to an equivalent BA/BSc Ordinary, where available.
